Title Policy and Pedagogy for School and Social Inclusion

In this lecture I will develop an argument for policies and practices on inclusion in schools and communities. This will draw on a recent large scale 4 year multi-site, multi-professional study of children who do not access meaningful education. I will consider the implications of this denial of access to what is a basic human right in terms of the consequences for children and young people and schools.
